- ATTENDENCE
 - o Mrs. Folsom noted that Regan Lyon, NAC, has been invited to join our meetings to better involve National SW and AAS members.
 - o Miss Rouillier, LtCol Brown, and Miss Abbate have family commitments.
- ALUMNI ORGANIZATION
 - o After settling in Korea, Lt Ageton has been assisting Mrs. Folsom with keeping the new people updated in the yahoo group.
 - o Once all information has been organized, it will make it much easier to inform
- COINS
 - o With the new recruits we're getting we should keep the morale high and produce more coins since we promise it with membership.
- LOCAL EVENTS
 - o Mrs. Folsom has approximately 125 people that expressed interest in Local Events.
 - o Some ideas have been meeting at ARCONs, NATCONs, Social events such as a Barbeque, Community Service.
- WEBSITE
 - o Mrs. Folsom is waiting on the OK from the Exec Board to begin working on the Website.
 - o Mrs. Folsom would like to have information regarding each Area/Region located on our website as an easy reference for Alumni to gain knowledge about upcoming events in the area, as well as obtain contact information.
- PRINTING
 - o Miss Tabinowski obtained a quote from Vistaprint.com to print postcards. The cost for 100 post cards is \$18.74 (there is a 25% off sale, original price is \$24.99), plus shipping, etc. The price does go down when buying more postcards. Vistaprint does send coupons, etc for free printing occasionally.
 - o Miss Tabinowski mentioned Vistaprint also prints window decals for approximately \$2-3.50 each. (100 decals for \$3.50 each, 250 decals for \$500).
 - Mrs. Folsom will discuss decals with Robyn, past Region V President regarding her quoting as well.
- AAS-SW INVOLVEMENT
 - o Lt Lyon mentioned the big project for the NACs right now is reconstructing themselves because of the loss on the AAS side and trying to figure out the manuals.
 - o The National Staffs had things already rolling and are being pretty quiet at this point, possibly because of summer, but will pick up for Exec Boards.
 - o Lt Lyon also informed us of some new updates made at CHICON, which we will learn more about in the newsletter:
 - It is no long AAS/SW, but AAS-SW, and everything with a "/" has become a "-".
 - REO was changed to Region President
 - Silver Wings members will automatically be AFA members n the fall with their membership fees.
 - o Lt Lyon mentioned contacting local alumni wherever NATCON is for an Alumni Dinner. This way, Alumni will have other opportunities for events rather than just meetings.
 - o Lt Lyon suggested using AF Global to find National Staffs and Area/Region Staffs based on records from EMC, if said list exists. Mrs. Folsom mentioned LtCol Brown and Lt Wray have actually been using Global to find lost alum.
